However, these days are not characterized by contemplative moments and security for everyone. Young mothers in particular, who find themselves in difficult life situations, often experience a time of challenges and uncertainty. There can be many reasons for this, from early pregnancies and violence to traumatic experiences or inadequate family support.

The "Alte Mühle" in Waidhofen near Schrobenhausen not only offers these women a protected space, but also a therapeutic inpatient mother-child clearing service that helps the residents to overcome their traumas and discover their personal strengths. The facility, run by A.p.e. Familienhilfe in Hettenshausen, acts as a place of retreat, safety and hope, where women not only receive support, but also the opportunity to rebuild their lives. And yet the Christmas season is anything but easy for the residents of the "Alte Mühle" due to their situation.

In order to give them, as well as many other clients who receive outpatient care from A.p.e. Familienhilfe (including numerous families and young people), a little joy this year, the employees of BAUER AG and MBDA Deutschland GmbH fulfilled numerous wishes as part of a Christmas tree campaign. Together they collected over 250 parcels. The wishes ranged from board games and doll clothes to picture books and teaching materials.
